You are eligible to apply for scholarships even though you may not plan to attend a post secondary institution in your first year away from high school. **You must submit a Letter of Intent to pursue your post-secondary education in order to have funds held in trust.** If for some reason you have completed the application process but did not attend post-secondary in the fall of your graduation or if OHSRA has not received a copy of "tuition paid" in your name or "letter of attendance" from the post-secondary institution of your choice by June 1 (a full year after your high school graduation, the monies held in trust for you will be moved back into the scholarship fund). **YOU MUST make contact with us prior to that date** should your circumstances require a later starting date - example - winter term instead of fall. In order for OHSRA to hold your scholarship money in trust beyond the one (1) year, June 1 deadline the onus is on you to contact us! **Funds must be used within 2 years of graduation.** Upon receiving proof of paid tuition / receipts from any accredited vocational or trade school, post-secondary institution, the scholarship funds will be forwarded to you.
