 - 5. Letter of Intent (if applicable)
 - 6. Photo-Enclose a small graduation or cowboy hat picture for publication/promotion.
 - 7. Submit completed application on or before MAY 20, 2017.
 - 8. NO LATE APPLICATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED

You are eligible to apply for scholarships even though you may not plan to attend a post-secondary institution in your first year away from high school. You must submit a Letter of Intent to pursue your post-secondary education in order to have funds held in trust. If for some reason you have completed the application process but did not attend post-secondary in the fall of your graduation or if OHSRA has not received a copy of "tuition paid" in your name or "letter of attendance" from the post-secondary institution of your choice by June 1 (a full year after your high school graduation, the monies held in trust for you will be moved back into the scholarship fund). YOU MUST make contact with us prior to that date should your circumstances require a later starting date - example - winter term instead of fall. In order for OHSRA to hold your scholarship money in trust beyond the one (1) year, June 1 deadline the onus is on you to contact us! Funds must be used within 2 years of graduation. Upon receiving proof of paid tuition/receipts from any accredited vocational or trade school, post-secondary institution, the scholarship funds will be forwarded to you.
